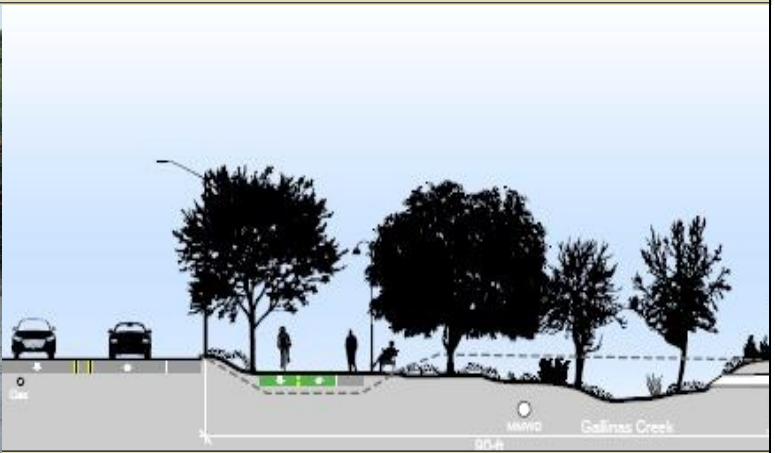


Community Meeting
